Some Interesting Facts About Our Church: The church windows were made by John McLeod, a man who was 6'-10" tall and died in 1932 at the age of ninety-nine. Three wood stoves provided heat until 1949 and coal oil lamps provided light until 1914, when they were replaced by electricity at a cost of \$73.40.
