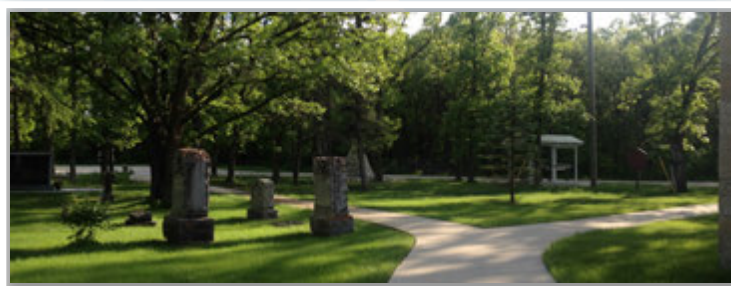

Treaty 1 was signed 146 years ago at Lower Fort Garry. What does Treaty 1 mean to you? Treaty is an invitation into sharing land for the benefit of all living things. Come learn about the ways this sacred commitment can breathe new life into our relationships with one another and the world around us.

These funds will be used by the Sandy Saulteaux Spiritual Centre to cover some of the costs of hosting this gathering.
