### McKenzie Plot Restoration

Roderick McKenzie was the Chief Trader for the Hudson's Bay Company. Restoration has begun on the McKenzie family plot located in Little Britain United Church Cemetery. The plot is located across from the main doors of the church. The first known burial in the cemetery was Catherine McKenzie daughter of Angelique and Roderick McKenzie in 1851. Roderick and Angelique were both buried next to their daughter after they passed away in 1859. The McKenzie's youngest son James was also buried there in 1860.
